

FIREPLACE FRONT FLOOR GLASS INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE HANDLE AND INSTALL THE PRODUCT CAREFULLY AS TEMPERED GLASS MAY SHATTER IF CORNERS AND EDGES COME INTO CONTACT WITH HARD SURFACES.

Before installing or using the product, read the installation, use, maintenance, and warranty instructions.

Prior to installing the product, check that the glass is undamaged and contains no defects. In the case of any defects being discovered, please contact the dealer. Andres Glass Solutions is not responsible for defects which may be caused by the following:

- ignoring the installation instructions for use of the product
- force majeure circumstances, an accident, or intentional or careless activity by the user or a third party
- any breakage of the glass or the discovery of defects after the product has been delivered to the user
- defects which occur as a result of foreign bodies, fluids, and insects inside the packaging or defects which may be caused by extreme temperatures
- normal wear-and-tear as a result of intensive use of the product.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Clean the floor area where you want to install the glass. There must be no debris or other materials under the glass that could cause unevenness of the glass and visually disturbing details.
2. Carefully remove the glass from the packaging and clean the side that will be facing down when installing. Make sure the glass is free of fingerprints and debris.
3. Carefully place the glass in the desired location.
4. Clean the top surface of the glass.
5. Make sure the glass does not move on the floor. You must check the floor for unevenness before ordering the glass.

MAINTENANCE OF THE GLASS:

- Clean the glass surface regularly with a cleaning agent designed for this purpose.
- Occasionally lift the glass off the floor and clean the underside and floor for any dust buildup.

REMEMBER:

- The glass must be installed on a flat surface.
- The glass must not be cut.
- The glass should not be installed on a carpeted surface.
- Despite the strength of tempered glass, avoid dropping hard or sharp objects on the glass surface, as cracks or breakage may still occur.
